

**Associate Research Scientist position, Lamont-Doherty Earth Observatory of Columbia University**

The Lamont-Doherty Earth Observatory of Columbia University invites applications for an Associate Research Scientist to study ocean acidification and ocean warming across the last deglaciation, using geochemical signatures of boron isotopes and Mg/Ca in fossil shells of planktic foraminifera.

Candidates should have a PhD in Earth Sciences; experience in planktic foraminifera identification and geochemical analysis using TIMS and ICP-MS is preferred.

Appointments are made on a fiscal year basis and are eligible for renewal each July 1, contingent upon performance and funding.
